-Voting Process

Conference Stats: The President acknowledged first-time attendees for their efforts to improve themselves by attending and furthering their education, seeking a better understanding of legislation and how it impacts county government. Tisa Smart-Washington was randomly selected as the first-time attendee of the year.

The President recognized all state directors and state presidents in attendance.

Motion to accept by Joe Grisolano, seconded by Chris Craft. Discussion: Three spoke against allowing staff. Two spoke in favor.

Mike Diskin to amend bylaws to remove any language adding staff members to be eligible, removing them. Article 5. Seconded by Michelle McBride. The President called for a vote on the motion. 15 for, 26 against. Motion failed.

Motion to table amendment by Michelle McBride, seconded by Nancy Weeks. 10 for, 26 against. Motion failed.

Chris Craft made a motion to amend the motion to only allow 1 staff member on the board, seconded by Shilo. One comment was made that it does not matter if we allow one of two staff members. Vote was called. 5 for, 18 against. Motion failed.

Chris Craft called for the vote on the original motion: 23 in favor, 12 against, 9 abstained. Motion carries.
